Opening an account online with UniCredit Bank

Online banking has never been more important than it is this year. In addition to ordering food and paying cheques, now you can also open a bank account at UniCredit Bank without leaving home. It takes only 20–30 minutes to become an account holder, and you don't even have to visit a branch to sign a contract.

UniCredit Bank has launched its online account opening service. The whole process is digitalised, as it does not require any personal presence, not even a signature. Customers can choose between 3 different accounts, depending on which one suits their financial habits best.

The 20–30 minute process can be completed in **4 simple steps**. Once the account package has been selected, the necessary declarations to open an account must be made, and the personal details and contact information required to open an account must be provided. The accuracy of these is verified by means of identification documents, and identity verification can be done by video call. After that, only the documents need to be signed, which can also be done online. If you wish, you can finalise the account opening process started online in person: you can identify yourself and sign the contract at any UniCredit branch in Hungary, where digital signatures are also possible, which is more environmentally friendly. Once the account has been opened and the agreement has been signed, you can log in to UniCredit eBanking and initiate or receive an immediate transfer no later than the next working day.

The person opening the account must meet certain criteria, such as being an adult Hungarian citizen, having a mobile phone number, opening an account for his/her own account and being a new customer of the bank.
